0.0 Operations

The operations that can be performed with the recovery service are:

- SR1: Complete recycling. (VREG 1988/2004 and 8.14.81 (ORRChem),Ap.2.15).

[Lithium Rechargeable Batteries]

1.0 Legislations

The current regulations in Switzerland and Liechtenstein are not the European WEEE (2012/19/CE) but VREG 1988/2004 ("Verordnung über die Rückgabe, die Rücknahme und die Entsorgung elektrischer und elektronischer Geräte") ("Ordinance on the Return, the Take-Back and the Waste Management of Electric and Electronic Equipment").

This law implements the SWICO/SENS standard that gives rise to the Swiss standard called ORDEA, which regulates the recovery service for electronic equipment including its batteries. The organization that is in charge of the implementation is the SWICO Recycling "Swiss association for Information, Communication and Organization technologies" of obligation for companies based in Switzerland that are importers, manufacturers or distributors.

For the special treatment for the waste lithium batteries (rechargeable and not rechargeable) that not are part of a electronic equipment, is INOBAT the organization in charge of the implementation of the recycling under the regulation 8.14.81 (ORRChem),Ap.2.15)

In the case of Teknoservice, the standard is not applied because it is not one of the figures contemplated, nor is it a manufacturer, importer or distributor in Swiss territory. However Teknoservice voluntarily applies the Swiss standard and it is registered in INOBAT and in Swico. Number Register 271401 as "OFFICE /IT PC" .
